Counsellor's Corner

If things go wrong at school

We all want the very best for our children, especially at school. As parents we think of school as a safe place that our child can learn and grow.

It is then difficult when things are not always that way and go wrong. Most children will experience conflict or peer rejection at some point through their school life, difficulty at different transition points and breakdowns in friendships.

How we react to this is one of the most important parenting tasks we face in showing our children that we support them and that we are there for them.

Top parenting educator Michael Grose has put together some suggestion of how to best deal with the situation if it arises:

- 1: Stay calm and rational. Our natural response it to protect and defend our children, but taking the time to think about the situation is a good idea, and helps to keep rational when dealing with the issue.
- 2: Get all the facts. Children often only see one side of the story and may not be able to see what contributed to a problem or upset someone. As a parent, it is our job to help our children process their understanding of their role in a situation.
- 3: Assess whether to go to school or not: Our children benefit from sharing their story with a trusted adult and problems can often be dealt with at this level by assisting them with some coping tips.
- 4: Approaching the school: Here at Good Counsel Primary we welcome parents to come and discuss any concerns about their child in a safe and supportive manner.
- 5: Solutions not blame: Meeting are far more productive if both parties are open to listen to each other's point of view and value their perspective.
- 6: Stay in touch: Sometimes problems can't be fixed straight away and ongoing communication may be needed.
