Principal's Column

Dear Parents,

This Wednesday March 8, we celebrate International Women's Day. This is a global celebration of the economic, political and social achievements of women in the past, the present and the future. The theme the Australian National Committee of UN Women has chosen for International Women's Day for 2017 is "Empower a Woman, Empower a Nation. Together we can empower women across the globe".

Where would we be without women in our lives - they are the fabric of a family that hold the threads together during times of difficulty, despair and tragedy.
