Dear Parents/Carers,

Thankyou to the many parents who were able to attend their children's class Parent Meeting last week. We had an exceptional turnout in most classes. If you were unable to attend please ensure you get a copy of the presentations from your child's teacher.

A focus this year in each classroom will be around "Morning Routine". Morning Routine is a daily 30 minute block of teaching time developing specific and targeted teaching to support Literacy and Numeracy.

The morning routine teaches concepts over continuous periods of time. It builds automaticity in children's learning and skills which leads to mastery. It's a great tool to improve students' vocabulary and academic background knowledge

The morning routine consists of these four elements:

- Time, Date & Weather
- Talk for learning / Geography / World events
- Sentence of the day
- 100 Day of learning

The research shows that we need to be: building an academic resilience in our students - 'Yes, school can be difficult but you'll be fine!'

developing a 'growth mindset' in our students, encouraging persistence and a healthy attitude towards learning; constantly talking to our students about their learning so they know you value their learning; continually reading and talking to our students. We know that regular reading improves fluency. We know that with increased fluency comes increased comprehension. Therefore, the more we read, the better we read. The more we read, our vocabulary increases. An increased vocabulary means greater comprehension because we know what the writer is talking about.

READING IS SO IMPORTANT!

This Friday morning we will celebrate the new school year with our whole school Mass. We will again welcome our new Staff and Students and our Student Leaders will receive their badge. Father Kerry will preside over our Mass as he has returned from holidays this week.

Flood plans - During events of high rainfall it is imperative that the safety of children and families is paramount. The saying "If it's flooded forget it" is a common one in the media today. Driving through flooded water is a huge risk and should not be undertaken. If due to flooding you cannot get your children to school, simply keep them at home and make a phone call. If flooding occurs while students are at school during the day, parents are to make the decision to collect children. 
