

Year 5 students spent three action packed days at Camp Barrabadeen on Tinaroo Dam. The students were fantastic and loved raft building, orienteering, canoeing, fishing,

swimming, crate stacking, rock climbing and completing the low ropes course. Thanks to the teachers and parent helpers who gave their time to provide the opportunity for our students to experience the outdoors.

As was alerted to in the past two school newsletters there has been an increase in the number of contagious illnesses within FNQ in the last month in particular whooping cough and gastroenteritis. All schools have been asked to send out the attached letter from Tropical Public Health Services Cairns.
