Dear Parents/Carers,

Today is Shrove Tuesday which is marked on the church calendar as the day immediately preceding Ash Wednesday which is celebrated in many countries around the world by consuming pancakes. Other countries, especially where the day is called Mardi Gras (Fat Tuesday in French) or Carnival Day, traditions centre around eating all the rich foods in the house before the fasting period of Lent.

Lent is a time when we focus on seeking penitence for our wrong doings. On Ash Wednesday we receive a cross on our foreheads made from the ash that was collected last Easter after burning the palm leaves. The symbolic cross reminds us of our mortality and that we are sorry for the things we have done that affect others, as well as the will for change and the hope of forgiveness.

This Lent, let us all reflect on our life choices and possible life directions through prayer. It is also a time to reflect with compassion for those less fortunate than ourselves - Project Compassion.

We commemorate the start of Lent tomorrow with two church services. The first at 9.00am for Prep - Year 2 with their Year 11 Good Counsel College buddies and the second at 10.00am for Year 3 - 6. The Year 11 GCC students buddying up with our Prep - Year 2 students has been a tradition for over 20 years. Our students certainly enjoy meeting their big buddy and the Year 11's look forward to the experience - remembering when they were in junior primary.

Last Friday, we celebrated our opening school mass with the church all but full. Thanks to the many parents/carers, friends and parishioners who attended. Congratulations again to our student leaders who received their badges that they are proudly wearing each day.

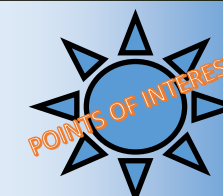
