Dear Parents/Carers,

Our students are currently finalising their end of year assessments and testing. This among the many pieces of student work completed over the past 17 weeks will be used to grade students, and their end of Semester 2 Report will be formalised. Once assessment and testing is complete, teachers will look at revising areas of the curriculum and then in the last week spend time preparing for the events of Week 9 - Graduation (Year 6), class activities and the School Christmas Concert on Thursday 6 December.

Teachers are currently finalising class lists for 2019. Many factors are considered when looking at class combinations of students - which students work well together; academic ability; combination of students to receive intervention; numbers of boys and girls and student requests of 3-5 people they would like to be with. After all these considerations, we attempt to put the best combination of classes together. A major impact on classes this year is that we have over 25 new students coming to Good Counsel Primary School in 2019. This is exciting and we are looking forward to welcoming them in the new year.

They have been spending time considering their leadership opportunities and will work as a group looking at their leadership qualities and then decide whether to stand

Next Thursday 29 November from 1.40pm, our students will have an opportunity to showcase their talents at our Good Counsel Primary School Talent Expo. The reason for having the expo is to showcase activities, sports or hobbies that students learn from professional tutors out of school that may be of interest to our students to enjoy or even join up.
