Dear Parents, As we head into Week 2, I am pleased that all bar two of our students have returned from holidays. Our new students are well on the way to settling into the school routine. I congratulate all parents for starting their students in correct school uniform. This does make us look smart especially with the correct 3. black shoes. Over the holidays several buildings were renovated ready for the first day of school. Construction of our new playgroup room in the Good Samaritan Hall was a major project which will begin use this Friday (see attached flyer).

Our Year 4B room has been extended to allow for an additional reading corner and the removal of the pod from Year 5GS and 6B classrooms has allowed for additional classroom space. New toilets and vinyl in both Prep classes was completed ready for use last week. Classrooms in the senior block will this term receive their new air conditioners. Painting throughout the school has freshened up the worn areas.

New classroom furnishings will be noticed as you enter rooms over the next few weeks. Stand-up desks have been added to Year 2 -6 classrooms and Hokki stools in Year 1 - 6 5. will be utilized by students during group work and to cater for differing learning styles. Both are aimed to assist with student engagement and concentration.

Over the break the IT Team has been hard at work installing a new computer server, preparing 50 new lap tops; retiring some older computers and setting up an additional bank of iPads. These will be in use in the early part of the term.

The following is an extract from Michael ^{6.} Grose's publication <u>Parenting Ideas</u> which may assist families at the start of the school year.

A new school year means a fresh start for students. Regardless of your child's performance last year, they start school with a clean slate. A break offers students the chance to begin new habits and adopt new *Z* behaviours. Here are 7 ideas to make the most of the fresh start and make this year your child's best year ever at school:-

good night's sleep, a healthy breakfast and some words of encouragement from you will help set a positive tone for a day of learning. This may mean that you adjust your morning routine so that

get ready for the day. **Establish work & study habits -** The most successful students are those who develop regular study habits that suit their lifestyle, their study style and their school's expectations. Find out the work expectations from your child's school and help them establish a work routine that matches.

- Make sure your child gets enough sleep - Many children are sleepdeprived, which impacts on their wellbeing and their learning. A good night's sleep consolidates learning, as well as assisting future learning. Children need between <u>10-12 hours of</u> <u>sleep each day</u>. Help kids get sufficient sleep by having a regular bedtime and get-up time each day. Have a 45 minute wind-down time each night, and remove screens and mobile phones from bedrooms.
- Insist kids exercise The old saying about 'a healthy body and a healthy mind' is so true. Exercise releases the chemicals needed for learning and wellbeing. Health professionals recommend a minimum of 60 minutes of exercise per day for kids of all ages. Encourage your child to play sport; promote free and active play and look for ways to make moving part of their daily lives.
- **Focus on being friendly** Schools are very social places requiring kids to negotiate many different social situations each day. Encourage kids to be open and tolerant; to be friendly; to be sensitive to others; to be involved in plenty of activities and to be social risktakers.
- **Develop self-help skills** Successful students are often well organised, self-directed and self-motivated. Such skills
- **Commit to your child going to school every day on time** - One of the most important things you can do to ensure your child has a bright future is to make sure he or she goes to school every day and gets there on time.
