#### Sacraments and one's Life in the Church...

Relationships grow through communication. Communication is more than just words. For Catholics, the relationship with God means connecting with him through words and gestures. The Scriptures are God's words to us and the Sacraments are gestures of God's love. The Catholic Church has named and formally recognised seven sacraments as powerful ways God reaches out to connect with believers. The Sacraments of the Church are visible signs that Fri 30.03 GOOD FRIDAY- Stations of the Cross God's presence is real and signs of his love.

Each of the seven sacraments of the Church emphasises a different dimension of one's relationship with God.

The Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist) highlight one's relationship with each person of the Trinity:

In Baptism one becomes a child of God the Father by being reborn spiritually. The symbols of water signify rebirth. Many of the prayers of baptism express belonging, being part of the family of God, and being heirs in God's kingdom. In Confirmation, one recommits to one's baptismal vows, and receives the gift of the Holy Spirit, being empowered to live the Christian life with conviction.

At one's first Communion (Eucharist), Catholics unite with Jesus through the Fri 11.05 Mother's Day Presentations mystery of Eucharist-the body and blood of Christ.

The Sacraments of Healing (Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick) highlight the Tue 15.05. Wed 16/5, Thu 17/5 NAPLAN merciful nature of God, while the Vocational (or Mission) Sacraments (Matrimony, Holy Orders) illuminate our call to intimacy with Him to share his love with others. www.cathfamily.org
