Counsellor's Corner

Helping your child build positive friendships can be difficult, but remember that friendship is a healthy part of their emotional and social development and children who struggle to make friends can often feel lonely and distressed.

As parents we can help by:

Providing opportunities for play dates out of school – Play time at school is short and can be very busy, so providing children with the opportunity to explore friendships out of school is very important. Children can learn to share their toys, discuss hobbies and interests and learn new friendship skills in a more relaxed environment.

Teaching positive skills by being a role model – using good eye contact, showing empathy, being interested in what others have to say, using a friendly voice and remembering to smile.

Helping solve conflict – Children often struggle to resolve friendship conflict, and parent assistance is best given by being supportive and talking things through with your child. Allowing them to express their feelings and asking them what they would do next is a good way of assisting them build more mature social skills.

Each child's self-concept is made of his or her strengths, fears, likes, dislikes, happy moments, traumatic events and so on. As children gain fuller pictures of themselves, they gain more confidence in their capabilities and they feel better about themselves—they are building good self-concepts. Children must value themselves before they can relate positively to one another and can value each other in a way that promotes self-esteem. We need to help children recognise their own uniqueness. Promoting positive self-image can be described using these words at home and at school: caring, trusting, nurturing, accepting, encouraging, warm, security, non-threatening, positive, non-judgemental, comfortable.
