Principal's Column

Dear Parents,

Exciting news for Good Counsel Primary in 2016. After much planning financially with budgets, I can announce the following initiatives for Good Counsel Primary School for next year.

1. 14 classes which means we will not have any composite classes
2. Transition teacher 3 mornings per week to assist students in the transition from Prep to Year 1. We have trialled this in 2015 and it has been great for students who need assistance in literacy and numeracy
3. Role M - This Maths program which helps students across the school will be extended to 5 days per week. Currently we have 54 students working in small groups building their number knowledge.
4. For all families, the school tuition fee will have a country discount offered. This will equate to an approximate discount of 10% of tuition fees on top of Diocesan tuition discount
5. One year trial of tuition fee discount in 2016 for holders of means-tested health care and pension concession cards. This is a Diocesan wide initiative aiming to make Catholic Schools more affordable. The discount of 70% is for tuition fees only and does not apply to levies. (See attached fee schedule)
6. Additional counselling service in 2016 will see a school counsellor here at Good Counsel Primary School 2 days per week which is an increase from this year.

These initiatives will enhance the excellent education that your children already receive here at Good Counsel. We will continue with the quality service that we currently provide.

This Thursday night, we have Susan McLean presenting a parent information session on Growing Up Online. The main

focus of the talk is to make parents more aware of the potential dangers and safety tips that are imperative for all parents raising children in today's technological world today. This talk is aimed at parents of children of all ages 3 to 18 years.
