I have included some important information that Susan shared with us regarding the age restrictions for particular internet sites and some safety tips.

### AGE RESTRICTIONS

Almost every site that requires you to sign up will have a minimum age restriction of 1. 13 years. This can be found in the Terms and Conditions of Use. Some sites that are particularly dangerous for children, due to 2. the risk of sexual offenders or adult content, will be listed as suitable for those over 17 or 18 years.

It was shocking that 50% of our Year 4 & 5 students were signed up for sites 13plus yet they are 10 and 11 years old.

# SAFETY TIPS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

- Don't send nude or semi-nude photos of yourself to others and don't forward any sent to you.
- If you receive a sexually explicit text or photo, delete it immediately and don't forward to anyone else. Tell the person who sent it, "I don't want any more texts like this." If the texts keep coming *report the situation to your telco who must act to warn the sender. If this does not work go to the Police.*
- Think before your act remember that once you've sent something you can't get it back or control who sees it, and that the photo or message might become public and be available for people to see for many years to come.
- Think about your future and how you want people to see you a picture taken now can have the potential to damage relationships **and** your career down the track. **Your digital reputation is very important.**
- Don't feel pressured into sending texts you don't feel comfortable with as with any sexual behaviour, you have the right to say 'NO'. As a general rule, don't have anything on your phone you would be embarrassed about.

#### SAFETY TIPS FOR PARENTS

Give children clear rules about what they can and can't do with their mobile phone.

- Become familiar with the technology your child is using i.e. Facebook, Tumblr, Twitter, Skype etc. and talk to them about privacy/security settings to help protect themselves from bullying/predators. Remember that most phones have instant access to the internet and social networking sites.
- Encourage your children to talk to you or another adult they trust if they have any problems or concerns around texts they have sent, received or forwarded, and reassure them this won't necessarily mean they will be asked to stop using the technology.
