Principal's Column

Dear Parents,

The miracle of prayer was evident last Friday at our 3Y Assembly. It was a very special morning for all students, staff and parents who attended the Prayer Assembly led by the Year 3 students. It was the first time many of them had seen Mark Thao since his serious accident at the Cairns Esplanade Pool some six months ago. Mark arrived at school early with his dad by his side, and closely protected by his brother Matthew and big sister Rebecca, talked to students before school. Many of Mark's classmates followed him around while in his wheelchair then when he wanted to get out of his chair and walk they were truly amazed at his progress. Mark was our special guest on Friday as the next day was his birthday. Delayne Balderson sang Happy Birthday on the microphone and Mark came forward to receive his birthday gift from the school community. Mr Thao thanked all in our school who had prayed for Mark and his family during his time of recovery and paid special tribute to Miss Yang and 3Y for their strength and daily prayers. At the conclusion of the Prayer Assembly, 3Y shared a birthday cake and spent time with Mark. Mr Thao discussed with me that Mark would continue 2 days each week at the Innisfail Inclusive Education Centre from the present into next year, regaining his skills and strength. He will visit Good Counsel Primary School for socialisation and he hoped in the future that Mark could return to Good Counsel to complete his Primary Education.

This Thursday our Year 5 students will spend time developing their leadership skills. Team Building activities, discussions and time for reflection will lead up to the students thinking about their leadership goals for 2016. Those students who then wish to stand for Leadership positions will nominate and write their speech to deliver to the class. At the end of the day all students in Year 5 will then vote for the nominated students. The elected School Captains, Sports Captains and the Student Council

members will be announced on the final Monday assembly (November 30). The process of electing Mini Vinnies representatives will take place early next year.

Classes and booklists for 2016 are being finalised over the next week and parents will be notified of their child's class by mid next week.

The new sports shirt orders have been placed and will be ready for the start of school. They will be available from our uniform shop. Opening hours for Linda will be advertised in the newsletter as well as in the Innisfail Advocate in mid January.

Our anticipated enrolment for 2016 will be above 310 students, showing strong growth. I have interviewed 22 new students across all year levels who are either moving from local schools or moving to town. This is a great sign for the future. All teaching positions are close to finalisation with class teachers being announced next week.

2016 will see three important student programs continued or increased. The Mini Lit / Mini Maths program targeting Year 1 students will be extended to three days a week 9.00am - 1.00pm with Mrs Rosanne Mifsud teaching targeted Year 1 students. Role M will be extended to 5 days targeting students across all year levels Prep - Year 6 in the area of Mathematics. Miss Cassie McLeish will continue working with these identified students. Rainbow Reading will continue to target students across Years 1 - 6 to improve reading and comprehension. All School Officers and Learning Support staff take small groups for high intensity coaching.

These supported programs are school funded and are on top of the many hours of classroom support that students receive each day at Good Counsel Primary School.
