BEACH THEME Dear Parents,

In the Church Calendar today, we celebrate Shrove or Pancake Tuesday. It is the day before Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent.

Shrove Tuesday is a reminder that Christians are entering a season of penance or fasting. The word 'shrove' derived from the past tense of the word "shrive" which means to bear confession clear away any wrong doings people had done.

In a way people were cleansed and they tidied up their lives. People often cleaned out their pantries in preparation for Lent by cooking the fat, flour and any meat they had before their time of 40 days fasting during Lent.

Lent begins tomorrow with Ash Wednesday. It is a season in the Church year of preparation for the Resurrection of Jesus Christ on Easter Sunday. Lent is a time marked by prayer, fasting and doing extra for others.

At our Ash Wednesday liturgy tomorrow, the students will received an ash cross on their forehead symbolising the dust from which we were made. The ashes are made from blessed palm branches, kept from the previous year's Palm Sunday Peninsula Trials. Mass.


