1 Go to dedicated web page set up to provide IT support for all students (click on the link below)

- 2 Click on the 'Log Support Request Icon'
- 3 Complete the online form Provide as much information about your issue, including the type of device, description, your school and your school email
- 4 Request will be logged Your request well be logged in CES Helpdesk and automatically allocated to the IT tech who supports your school
- 5 Call Back Time You will receive an email to your school email address, from your tech to schedule a Google Meet to resolve your issue.
- 6 Issue Resolved Your tech will work to resolve your issue. Tech's are limited wo what can be done remotely and on your home personal device.

NOTE: An adult needs to be present during the call back


Borrowing Library Books From School
