



#### Dear Parents/Carers

With only 4 school days until Good Counsel Primary returns to a form of normality, teachers are busily preparing to teach their full classes face to face. As of Monday 25 May, we expect all but a handful of students to be here on site. A couple of families have specific medical and or immune compromised children who will delay their return. Returning to our 'normal' will take time and we are following the Qld Government restrictions.

Guidelines as per our COVID19 Plan:-

- Parents are not permitted in classrooms or to engage with teachers face to face. Please contact them via email, Seesaw or phone. This is necessary to limit cross contamination among adults.
- In the morning when dropping off, and get your child to place their bag on the bag hooks outside their classroom.
- pickup, please practise social depart promptly.
- No whole school assemblies will take place this term. Our Student Council and Sports Captains will lead birthday and student awards each interviews, with siblings or mailed out. Monday and Friday morning.
- Please ring the school Admin Office prior to entering when collecting children for appointments.

Children returning (Year 2-6) on 25 May will bring their Remote Learning packs/tubs and devices (if school owned) and place them Liam on the seats or tables in the blue area.

All students will resume classes with their teachers as of 25 May. Teachers will take some time reinforcing classroom expectations, establishing routines, revising and teaching content.

For all the parents who took up the challenge of teaching their children at home - Well done! From the comments of some, they loved the experience and will miss it, for others they have been scarred for life and cannot wait for their children to return to the classroom. We appreciate that trying to teach remotely, run a household and for some, work from home is and was a mammoth task.

I also thank our Good Counsel Primary School staff who have worked tirelessly over the past 8 weeks. Our teachers who provided remote learning resources, have remained connected with students, marked samples of work that were uploaded, have done an amazing job of continuing to provide for all students on their educational


