Science is so important - most decisions we make in life are based on something to do with science. Science allows students to explore their world and discover new things. Science is one of the oldest and most important academic disciplines.

What is a Scientist? Someone who explores, observes, wonders, predicts, experiments, draws, invests, thinks and asks questions.

Some types of scientists in the world today-

- Agronomist - specialises in soils and crops
- Astronomer - studies stars, planets and galaxies
- Botanist - specialises in plants
- Cytologist - studies cells
- Epidemiologist - studies the spread of diseases
- Ethologist - studies animal behaviour
- Geneticist - studies how traits are inherited
- Marine Biologist - studies ocean plants

- Microbiologist - studies microscopic plants and animals
- Palaeontologist - specialises in fossils
- Physicist - studies matter, energy and how they are related
- Seismologist - studies earth quakes

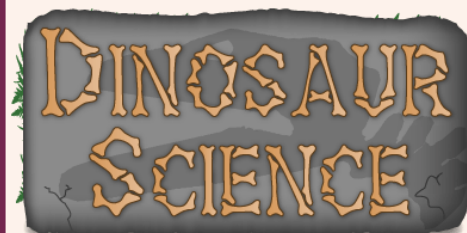
