

## Dear Parents/Carers,

Well 2021 is off to a great start with 17 new students (Yrs 1-6) settling in over the past week. Our 50 Prep children are learning new routines and becoming familiar with school life at Good Counsel Primary School. This Friday at our opening school year Mass, we will welcome our new students and ask them to proceed to the front of the Alter. Father Kerry will bless us for the new year and wish us all well for 2021. Due to our COVID-19 restrictions, we will have limited parent/carer seating at the back of the church.

Parents/Carers who attend must COVID-19 sign-in and sit socially distanced. Preference will be given to parents of student leaders who are receiving their badges, new students and prep parent/carers. Should you have any queries please contact myself or Mrs C.

We also welcome three staff in 2021. Mrs Denise Kenny is our Teacher Librarian and will be working with Years 3-5 students in class and all students in the library at lunchtime. Mrs Katie Cavallaro joins our Prep team working Monday to Wednesday and Mrs Sandip Kaur will be assisting our Diverse One of our key goals in 2021 is around Learners team with students and families who do not have English as their first language. Students have all settled well into learning and we are hopeful this the great start to 2021. enthusiasm will continue well into the semester.

With regard to building/grounds, all will have noticed the large raintree which unfortunately had to be removed over the holidays. The large branches were

posing a danger with several falling and crashing into the stage area late last year, so our contracted arborist advised we cut it down. The stump will remain as a seat with a concrete stage to surround it. On either side of the tree stump will be two shade structures for students to sit on at play time or during PE lessons. Finally our synthetic grassed area will be replaced to match up with the stage and concrete path. Many other small building upgrades were completed including painting, plumbing, blinds and cabinetry in classrooms and the Good Samaritan Hall over the summer break.

Over the next two weeks we have parent meetings timetabled in to take place in the Theatrette. These are an opportunity for parents/carers to meet class teachers and gain an insight into classroom expectations and routines as well as homework requirements. Due to our COVID-19 restrictions, only one parent/ carer per class family is to attend. Each class teacher has prepared a document which will be shared outlining the presentation.
