Here at GCP we want to help children develop active, positive lifestyles where children learn that exercise is important to their well-being and they develop a love of physical activity that they can carry on throughout their life. Therefore, this year Good Counsel Primary School is offering an after-school fitness program. The program is aimed to improve our students' fitness and sport skills in a fun atmosphere. Each session will include:

- Agility, Balance, Coordination and Strength training drills
- Introduction to the basic components of fitness—cardiovascular, endurance and strength
- Motor skills development and enhancement
- Fitness games
