- Focus on your child's strengths
- Take into consideration your child's effort and attitude to learning, not just the number of A's and B's
- Discuss the report with your child, talking about strengths first before at areas improvement. Ask for their opinion about how they performed and discuss concerns

Should you have concerns with elements of your child's report, make contact with your child's teacher early next term to discuss. A reminder that a printed copy of student reports will be sent home during Week 1 of next term.
