



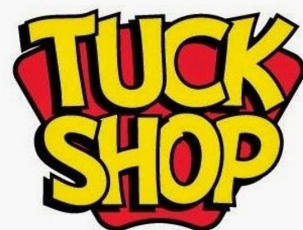
TERM FEES

We had hoped to return to a completed playground for our infant students. I was contacted today to say that there will be a delay in the installation back to the third week in August due to some staffing issues with the installers.

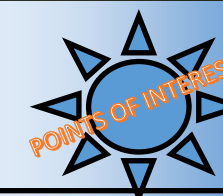
Good luck to all our athletes who will be competing on Wednesday afternoon and Friday at our Northern Zone Athletics Carnival for the Cassowary Coast District.
