Dear Parents/Carers,

It was wonderful to have a full school for Day 1 of Week 2 vesterday. The place was a buzz of very enthusiastic learners all engaged in each classroom. Class rules and expectations have been set, students have worked out their lunch time seating and play arrangements and hopefully know how they are getting home each day.

Our after school sporting trials for students in Year 5/6 are in full swing as well as our netball teams. Students are about to begin trials for cricket, touch and rugby league.

At the beginning of each year parking is an issue. A couple of friendly reminders from our local police force and School Administration:

- <u>Do not</u> park on Grace Street on either side of the crossing where it indicates 'no parking' - this does block the view of driver's who cannot see students, parents and staff at the crossing
- When using our Rankin Street Pick-Up zone - do not park and then leave your vehicle to enter the school grounds during the Pick-Up / Drop-Off times. This zone is designed to allow traffic to flow through
- Do not park on the road on Rankin Street and call students to your car. Please park or join the Pick-Up line
- Be patient at the Owen Street Pick-Up zone - The top supervised Pick-Up area is for Good Counsel Primary School students and their Good Counsel College siblings (if
- Below the crossing is for Good Counsel College students Pick-Up ONLY
- A Reminder that Rankin Street is a 40km/h zone

The Presentation of the Lord—Feast Day 2 February...
