

#### Dear Parents/Carers.

It is difficult to believe that we are in Week 10 of Term 1 and the Easter holidays begin this weekend. Term 1 has been very busy with much teaching and learning in each and every classroom, assessments, intervention, NAPLAN for Yr 3 & 5 students mixed in with some time for dress ups, sporting and cultural activities.

Last Friday we began our preparation for



Easter (which this year is on the middle weekend of the holidays), with our 3DK Palm Sunday Praver Assembly: Jesus was welcomed into Jerusalem as a King, riding on a donkey - A Triumphant Entry! The mood changed this week with 6D presenting the Last Supper this morning when Jesus was betraved by one of his own Disciples and the sombre scenes will be depicted by 5SD with the Stations of the Cross on Thursday morning. As we did this morning, again on Thursday, we leave the assembly area in silence.

This week we will have our life size cross installed in time for Easter into the Music Room walkway. The Cross which has been cut from the giant raintree off the oval will form the central focus of our "Sacred Quiet Space" where members of our School Community can sit, pray or just spend some time in reflection.

Wednesday will be our Sports Interhouse Cross Country, held here at school. Students will run their 500m, 1km or 3km course on the school precinct with staff standing on key sites of the track. If utilising the Prep carpark, please be aware that teachers will be monitoring the entry and exit as runners will cross these areas. Parent viewing areas will be clearly barricaded off so as not to encroach on the track. Students can wear their sports shorts, shoes and a shirt of their colour house.

Congratulations to the MacKillop Sports House which has won our first Sports Trophy for 2023, taking out the Lap running last week by over 250 laps. Well done! Who will be

Champion House this Wednesday morning? To finish the term, we are this year celebrating Harmony Day - Everyone Belongs. A day to celebrate our cultural and ancestral diversity. I was amazed when discussing our plans for Harmony Day with some Year 5 students that many had no idea of their ancestral heritage, so hopefully this Friday will be a day of learning and celebration. Students are encouraged to wear either an item of clothing that celebrates their cultural or ancestral background or something 'orange' as this is the colour used to signify Harmony Day. Some of our students will be presenting our final Prayer Assembly for the term. It should be one not to miss.

My last thankyou is to all our staff who have worked very hard this term to provide the learning opportunities for all students here at Good Counsel Primary School. Enjoy the Easter break and return refreshed ready for Term 2. My Easter message to families is to try to attend one of the Easter Liturgical celebrations wherever you are as it is very easy to think Easter is only about bunnies and chocolate eggs.
