
Over the next three weeks, we have three opportunities to dress up. This Friday is

Sports House Captains Prayer Assembly...

The Clancy House is named in honour of Father Clancy, the long serving and hardworking Parish Priest. He was here in Innisfail when construction of Mother of Good Counsel Church commenced in 1924 and blessed and opened in 1928. Clancy House honours all priests, past and present, who have served in our community up until

Father Kerry Crowley, to the present day. The colour green reminds us that together, as one community, we are a symbol of hope to all around us. The heart featured on the Clancy flag is to remind us that our school began as the Sacred Heart School when Fr Michael Clancy was parish priest.



The MacKillop Sports House is named in honour of Saint Mary MacKillop of the Cross, and all Australians who have served in Catholic Education to spread the Good News of the Gospel. The colour purple reminds us that we are compassionate and always ready to forgive ourselves and others. The symbol featured on the

MacKillop banner reminds us of the Trinity, the symbol which was part of St Mary MacKillop' religious habit.



The Marcellin Colour House is named in honour of Marcellin Champagnat, the founder of the Marist Brothers and the valuable contribution his order has made to our community life. The colour red reminds us of the flame of fire, the Holy Spirit alive and at work in our community. The symbol featured on the Marcellin flag has the letter M to remind us of St Marcellin whose silhouette is also there.



The Polding Sports House is named in honour of Bishop Bede Polding. Bishop Polding formed the Order of the Sisters of the Good Samaritan who served in this school and community of Innisfail for 90 years until 1992. The colour blue reminds us that

we are people of prayer. Through prayer we are united in faith, hope and love – a family of God – people brought to life sharing in the sacraments of Christ The symbol featured on the Polding flag is the Bishop's Mitre to remind us of the importance of his role in sending the
