GOOD COUNSEL PRIMARY SCHOOL NEWSLETTER

Dear Parents/Carers.

Week 6 is a busy week on the meeting front with our Safest Committee meeting last night to discuss the findings of the traffic flow investigations from last term. The main items of interest were assessing the risk of accidents, involving pedestrians and vehicles. The school precinct comprising of Rankin, Owen, Ernest, Grace and Alice Streets is a relatively small area with high traffic counts during peak drop off and pick up times. Over 700 students and 120 staff are impacted daily.

The very comprehensive report from McIlveen & Associates Cairns, details over 50 significant items requiring inconsistent attention from speed signage on the precinct, pavement markings, infrastructure and traffic flow next improvement cycle. concerns.

It was decided at the Safest Meeting that our next step would be to gather some relevant survey data before meeting again to present our corrective action requests to the Cassowary Coast Regional Council. Please be on the lookout for the survey as every parent/ carer response will be vital.

Tonight we have our combined School's Board meeting with Principals and their school representatives from Good Counsel College, St Rita's Babinda and St Rita's South Johnstone, as well as St John's Silkwood. Much sharing of individual school issues and initiatives as well as looking at policies takes place at this bi-monthly meeting.

The next three days of this week will be taken up with our 5-Year School Review -The ACER Review team is led by Mrs Laurelle Allen and Mr Brett Manion. The Review occurs every 5 years and looks at current school practices to ensure we are providing the best education for our students. They look at our school documents for teaching and learning, interview staff, parents and students, and visit classrooms during their three-day visit.

At the end of the week, the team present a report on current practices, progress toward improving the quality of teaching and learning and well being. They will identify existing strengths and provide recommendations to inform the school's


