Welcome to our final week of term and prayers have been answered with hopefully fine weather for our sporting events. Yesterday we were bathed in sunshine for our field events for Yr 3-6 students (who are 9-12 years old). A great start to the week with some surprise results from individuals including Ruby Torrisi who broke the 10years girls shot put (8.19m), and Hannah Sinton who equalled the 10years girls High Jump (1.20m), Leighton Genocchio who broke the 11years girls High Jump (1.24m), and Braxton D'Urso who broke the 11years boys Long Jump (4.53m).

Today we had great spirit on show for the Ball Games and class tug o' war.

On Thursday we are all keen to walk to Callendar Park for our sprints, 200m, 800m, relays and novelty events.
