With a sense of the First Nations country upon which Good Counsel Primary is situated, where learning and ceremony have taken place over many thousands of years, we acknowledge the Mamu People and pay our respects to all Elders—past, present and emerging.

Dear Parents/Carers,

National Reconciliation Week (NRW) is recognised in Australia from 27 May to 3 June. Here at Good Counsel Primary we celebrate Reconciliation on Friday 2 June at our Prayer Assembly. It is a time for all Australians to learn about our shared histories, cultures and achievements and to explore how each of us can contribute to achieving reconciliation in Australia. The date for Reconciliation Week commemorates two significant milestones in Australian history - The 1967 Referendum and the High Court Mabo decision. On 27 May 1967, 90% of Australians voted to give the Australian Government power to make laws for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island people and recognise them in the census. On 3 June the Australian High Court passed the decision to legally recognise Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples as the Traditional Owners and custodians of lands. This decision paved the way for Native Title. We strive for reconciliation to live in the hearts, minds and actions of all Australians as we move forward, creating a nation strengthened by respectful relationships between the wider Australian community and our First Nations peoples. Everyone is welcome to attend our Reconciliation Prayer Assembly this Friday at 8.35am.

Last week, Laurelle Allen and Brett Manion (ACER Review Team) visited GCP to conduct our 5-Year School Review. The Review looked at 9 Domains of school life from Teaching and Learning; Curriculum delivery; School Improvement; Student Engagement and Differentiation; Resourcing & Wellbeing.

The team interviewed 51 Students, 16 Parents, 18 Teachers and 14 School Support Officers as well as classroom visits and general observations. The initial feedback from the Review Team has been overwhelmingly positive and a full report highlighting commendations and recommendations will be sent by the end of term, once ratified by the external reviewers. From the Review, we hope to have areas to work on for the next review cycle and give us directions for our Strategic Plan 2024--2028. Thank you to all who gave feedback during the Review process. More information to follow once we receive our report.

We are about half way through Prep 2024 Interviews - If you have a Prep child or know of families with a Prep child who has not yet applied to Good Counsel Primary, please encourage them to complete an online application form to place them on our list as places are filling up.


