Fair Play Voucher Information

FairPlay Fair Play is a program under the

Queensland Government's \$1.3 billion Activate! Queensland 2019-2029 strategy focusing on where people live, learn, earn and play to embed activity in their daily lives and encourage lifelong movement. The program provides eligible Queensland children and young people aged 5 to 17 (inclusive) who can least afford to join a sport or recreation club with a voucher valued up to \$150 for membership and/or registration fees. The latest round of Fair Play Vouchers opened on 24 January 2024. For more information and to apply visit: https://www.qld.gov.au/recreation/sports/funding fairplay/apply If your child does not have access to a valid Centrelink Health Care Card/Pensioner Concession Card, you may request assistance through the school who is a referral agent for the program, and has been granted a limited number of vouchers.
