Fair Play is a program under the Queensland Government's \$1.3 billion



Activate! Queensland 2019-2029 strategy focusing on where people live, learn, earn and play to embed activity in their daily lives and encourage lifelong movement. The program provides eligible Queensland children and young people aged 5 to 17 (inclusive) who can least afford to join a sport or recreation club with a voucher valued up to \$150 for membership and/or registration fees. The latest round of Fair Play Vouchers opened on 24 January 2024. Issuing of vouchers is at the principal's discretion and aims to assist those who would struggle to meet the costs associated with membership and registration of a sport or recreational club. With a sense of the First Nations country upon which Good Counsel Primary is situated, where learning and ceremony have taken place over many thousands of years, we acknowledge the Mamu People and pay our respects to all Elders—past and present.

Dear Parents/Carers.

This week we celebrate or actually remember two significant events in our Church life. Shrove Tuesday or Pancake Tuesday is the final day before Lent begins. The word 'shrove' is from the English word 'shrive', which means to give absolution for someone's sins by way of confession and doing penance. Shrove Tuesday was named after the custom of Christians to be 'shriven' before the start of Lent. The custom of eating pancakes was to eat up all the rich food in the house prior to the ritual fasting of the Lenten season which begins with Ash Wednesday. Ash Wednesday signifies the first day of Lent-a time of fasting, abstinence, and prayer. Today in school we recognise Ash Wednesday and the Lenten season (46 days - prior to Easter) as a time of reflection on how we treat others. For primary school children we would rather see them doing something extra to help at home than fasting or giving up something sweet or a treat. The ashes the students receive on their foreheads symbolises both death and repentance. The words said can be "Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel" or for the younger classes "Turn back to God". The students respond with "Amen". ashes come from the burned palm leaves left over from the previous year's Palm Sunday services.

Last Friday we announced our final Yr 6 leadership positions with our Mini Vinnies Chapter representatives receiving their badges and all Year 6 students receiving their Yr 6 badge.

The GCPS Mini Vinnies chapter was instigated by Mrs C back in 2002 when she was teaching Yr 7. Mini Vinnies is such an important part of the fabric of our school, led by our Yr 6 students. Classes attend meetings to decide on appropriate fundraising activities, all highlighting the need to do something for others less fortunate than ourselves. The money raised is used to assist the local St Vincent De Paul works here in Regards Liam

Innisfail. Over the years, other funds have assisted the north western QLD flood victims, families in the SE QLD floods, and bushfire victims. When assisting those outside of town, we connect with a local school who works directly with families so the funds help those impacted. The 2024 Chapter looks forward to helping others this year.
