

Dear Parents/Carers.

This Friday at GCPS, we will be celebrating Harmony Day. Our Friday Prayer Assembly will be led by our Year 6 students. Harmony Day celebrates diversity, aims to foster inclusiveness and respect for different cultures and the valuable contribution they make to our school, local community, and Australia.

The 2024 Harmony Day's theme is Everyone Belongs. Friday's dress code is Sports Uniform, or an orange shirt with sports shorts, or an item of clothing related to their national/cultural heritage. Children in costume may need to change into their sports uniform if they want to protect the outfit. Friday is NOT a free dress day.

Please do not purchase an orange shirt especially for the day.

Prior to assembly, the Year 6 students will be distributing an orange ribbon to children in Friday Sports shirts, as the colour orange is significant to Harmony Day.

Additionally, students may bring something small to share from their lunch box that is culturally significant to their heritage. Usually, we do not share our lunch foods, however, there will be an exception made for Harmony Day.
