A big 'Hi' from Mrs Russell from her visit to St Peter's Basilica, in Vatican City, Rome, Italy. One of the holiest sites of Christianity and Catholic Tradition, it is traditionally the burial site of St. Peter, who was the head of the twelve Apostles of Jesus and, according to tradition, the first Bishop of Antioch and later the first Bishop of Rome, rendering him the first Pope. This is where Pope Francis—head of the Catholic Church, Bishop of Rome, and sovereign of the Vatican City State, presides over the mass when he is able.
