### Our Lady of the Rosary...

The Rosary is a Scripture-based prayer. It begins with the *Apostles' Creed*, which summarises the great mysteries of the Catholic faith. The Our Father, which introduces each mystery, is from the Gospels. The first part of the *Hail Mary* is the angel's words announcing Christ's birth and Elizabeth's greeting to Mary. St. Pius V officially added the second part of the *Hail Mary*. The Mysteries of the Rosary centre on the events of Christ's life. There are four sets of Mysteries: Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious and—added by Saint John Paul II in 2002—the Luminous. The repetition in the Rosary is meant to lead one into restful and contemplative prayer related to each Mystery. The gentle repetition of the words helps us to enter into the silence of our hearts, where Christ's spirit dwells. The Rosary can be said privately or with a group.

Please join with us for Friday's Prayer Assembly as a group of Mini Vinnies lead us in a decade of the Rosary in honour Mary's Feast Day on Monday 7 October and to remind us this is the month of the Rosary.
