Why is attendance important?

A bright future for your child starts with good school attendance everyday, all day. Good attendance doesn't quarantee outcomes for students, however, positive outcomes are unlikely to occur without good attendance.

It is important that children develop regular attendance habits at an early age. Every minute matters—being just 10 minutes late every day adds up to nearly half a year of lost schooling from Prep to Year 12. Our school bell rings each morning at 8:35am-please endeavour each day to get to school before the

Let's put in a big effort this term. Last term 80 students attended every day and 170 only had one or two days off. A great effort!

Obviously students will get sick from time to time and this cannot be helped if they are ill. It is vital that they're only away on the days they are genuinely sick. Setting good sleep attending in Weeks 3/4 and Prep and Year 2 patterns, eating well and exercising regularly can make a difference.
