With a sense of the First Nations country upon which Good Counsel Primary is situated, where learning and ceremony have taken place over many thousands of years, re acknowledge the Mamu People and pay our respects to all Elders- past and present.

Dear Parents/Carers.

Last week 5 staff travelled to Sydney and Wollongong to visit schools suggested by our Mathematics and Literacy consultants. We were looking at three distinct areas-Mathematics—using manipulatives and the quality teaching of maths. Literacy Blocks-Morning Routine, writing and grammar; Diversity-how schools are catering for the diverse needs of their learners.

We funded the majority of the trip with Professional Renewal Leave Funds and certainly saw some amazing work that is occurring in schools and we have some suggestions of strategies that we can add to our curriculum to improve our current ways of working. We also witnessed that we are already ahead of the game in so many areas which is great affirmation for our staff who work so hard for our students. The three schools to highlight were Kemblawarra PS (130 students), Jasper Rd PS (840 students) and Greenway Park PS (640) students. These three were all very different settings and had students from very low and high socioeconomic backgrounds. Greenway Park PS drew most of its students from migrant families; Jasper Rd PS had the majority of families living in an area that the median house price was over 3 million dollars, while Kemblawarra PS has 30 percent of its students attending from the local mission.



Attendees were Amy McElhinney and Beth Hayley (Diversity); Maree Helm (Learning and Teaching); Jess Sinton (Prep) and myself.

Mrs Emma Donaldson, CES Consultant -Teaching and Learning, also travelled with us. Just visiting schools we saw so many things that we can implement. If we do not visit and see best practice we cannot improve our practices.

Next week will be Mrs Pamvouxoglou's last LOTE session with our Year 5/6 classes. Mrs P has travelled specially for us this year to continue her Italian lessons while also working four days a week at St Michael's, Gordonvale. This has been a huge effort and she has decided to cut back on travel and preparation to focus on her young children who are very involved in sport and dance. We all thank Anna for bringing joy, firstly to our Arts Program, and then LOTE for our students. We wish her all the best in her future teaching career.

This week we have new students beginning their educational journey-Indie Briggs 1GS, Stella McKee 1D and Max McKee 3M. We wish them a smooth transition as they enter their new classes this week. Please make them feel welcome when you see them.
