A special thank you to our students who, for the most part, were well behaved and school was relatively quiet.

It seems an age ago, but the last days before my leave were on the Year 5 Camp to Tinaroo. This was an amazing experience for our students as they participated in many and varied activities all centred around challenging themselves, developing leadership and team work skills, and for some, being away from home for the first time. Our students took on all challenges with such eagerness and it was a pleasure working with them. Many thanks to Sinton. Mrs Stephenson and Mrs Paterson for their organisation and commitment to the camp. Thanks also to our parent volunteers who assisted with supervision, activities and even washing up. Our Year5s now look forward to their Leadership Day on 20 November when they consider nominating for positions in 2026.

This week (Thursday), our Year 4 students are off to Herberton for their excursion. It will be an early start as they have a new itinerary this year visiting the Mining Museum as wel at the Herberton Historic Village. It is a full day of learning about our early pioneering history in Far North Queensland, focusing on the past. There are 60 original buildings, antique motor vehicles, the original classrooms, small engines, blacksmith display, printing press and so much of yesteryear. Our students are always amazed at how life was in the early days before electricity, mobile phones and life as we know it today. We will share some pictures in next week's newsletter.
